She investigates a maze of political power and whispered secrets until she discovers the truth: a terrible betrayal that puts herself—and her best friends—in mortal danger.

Kathryn "Kit" Kittridge is a foreign ambassador, Robin Hood's shapeshifting twin sister, and spy. She'll do anything to stop the invasion threatening her home. But when her king asks her to marry Nottingham's complex and dangerous ruler, King John, in the name of military alliance, she wrestles with the question of how far God expects her to go in the name of duty.

Reluctant heir to his famous father's legend, Robert Bryan Jr.—better known as the second Robin Hood—has waited his whole life to explore the wilderness as a Touched ranger and search for dragons. But when a kidnapping plot consumes the attention of his fiancé and predators beyond his powers threaten the safety of his crew, he must deal with these new problems if he ever wants to have his future—or their lives—secure again.
